Twelve CSI Charter Schools Renewed by Board of Directors

Denver, CO (December 15, 2020) – Eleven charter schools authorized by the [Colorado Charter School Institute](http://www.csi.state.co.us) (CSI) were renewed for varying contract terms at the December 15th board meeting. One school, Global Village Academy-Northglenn, was [renewed in November](#).

In a typical year, the main body of evidence for renewal comes from CSI’s [annual charter school review](#), which evaluates a school’s performance against academic, operational, and financial performance frameworks.

The suspension of state assessments during the 2019-2020 school year created a gap in the academic evaluation of school and, as a result, the charter [renewal process was adjusted](#) for the 2020 renewal cycle.

CSI Director of Evaluation and Assessment Ryan Marks oversees the CSI renewal process. Marks shares: “Throughout the charter renewal process, we focused on providing flexibility and adjusting our processes to help support schools as they navigate charter renewal during the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite the disruption in state academic testing, we were able to create processes that allowed us to uphold our values as an authorizer while being responsive to school and community needs.”

The process included typical components such as a renewal application and school site visits, which took place virtually this fall. CSI made baseline recommendations for renewal schools based on academic data from 2014-15 through 2018-19. Financial and organizational outcomes from the 2019-20 school year were included for consideration as well. Schools were also given the option to provide a supplemental body of evidence with data from the 2019-20 school year if it would materially impact the contract term.

Renewal contract terms varied, with five years being the maximum contract length a school can receive. Some schools were granted performance contracts, which automatically add or remove additional years if the schools meet certain performance benchmarks.
