As a statewide charter school authorizer, the Colorado Charter School Institute (CSI) seeks to foster high-quality public school choices that serve all students.

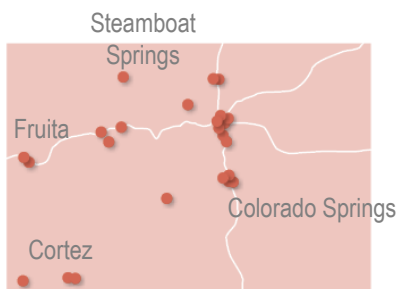
What We Believe

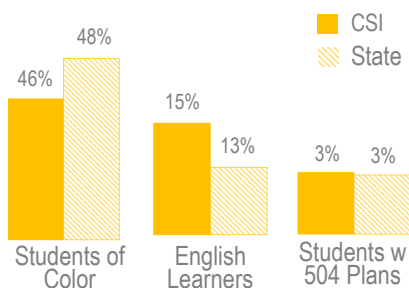
Our Schools
