Thirteen CSI Charter Schools Earn 'Performance with Distinction' Rating

Denver, CO (December 17, 2024) – Thirteen charter schools authorized by the <u>Colorado</u> <u>Charter School Institute</u> (CSI) earned "Performance with Distinction" ratings for their performance in the 2023-2024 school year. Schools that receive this rating rank in the top 25% of all schools in Colorado with reportable academic data and have demonstrated strong financial and organizational performance as well.

CSI assigns schools a performance rating each fall based on academic, financial, and organizational performance from the previous school year. The CSI ratings align with the state but adds a "Performance with Distinction" rating within the state's top rating of "Performance" to connote the highest performing schools in the state.

CSI Chief of Authorizing and Accountability, Ryan Marks, shares: "CSI is dedicated to maintaining model authorizing practices, keeping schools informed about their performance, providing valuable insights to support innovation, growth, and improvement, and ensuring transparency for both the school and the public. We are excited to see so many CSI schools – close to one third of the portfolio and with a wide range of diverse locations and educational models – receiving the Performance with Distinction rating."
